Session Timetable

- Please choose from the timetabled 25 minutes sessions (5 minutes to move between sessions). Most sessions are repeated 2 or more times with the same content so you only need to attend once. Most sessions contain 3-4 speakers representing different areas of the industry (e.g. a 'Law' session might contain a practicing solicitor, legal advisor and a legal administration worker) . They will talk about their personal journey into that industry and what the benefits and challenges are in their jobs. There will be a time for student questions at the end of the session.
- **Coloured sections:** Please include at least ONE red highlighted section about either TAFE or University (or both) and ONE purple highlighted section.
- Please take note of your highlighted compulsory lunch time for your school
- Please take note of your highlighted compulsory session to look at the stalls
- You can also choose to have ONE extra session at the stalls if you like which will also give you a break from the stalls. This is optional and only available once per student
- **Try to include at least one session in a skills shortage or expanding industry e.g. primary industries, health, allied health, mental health, aged care, trades, education**
- Try to learn about a career areas that interests you which includes skills that you enjoy practicing.
- Don't be afraid to learn about an industry you have not ever thought about before.
- Also think about jobs that will help you while you are studying (e.g. provide you with a casual income and work skills).
- Think about what you would like to do if you choose to have a gap year.
- Talk to your parents and teachers about the skills areas they think you should explore based on what you are good at.
- The defence sessions are very practical and entertaining and have been very popular in the past.
